



Small Group Discussion Guide – The Religion Business

Purpose: As a faith community, The Religion Business has potential to open hearts and minds. Reflect, ask questions, and share personal insights after watching each episode. Listen with respect and support each other's growth and perspectives. Use scripture to balance thoughts against the series, guide your bond, deepen your faith, and unite you in purpose.

Strategy: Watch one episode per week and discuss with your small group or gathering. The discussion should last anywhere from 30 minutes to 2 hours.

After watching each episode, discuss the following questions together:

1. What did you watch that you liked?

Share what stood out to you or what resonated with your beliefs or experiences.

2. What did you watch that you did not like?

Talk about anything that made you uncomfortable or raised questions.

3. What did you find confusing or didn't understand?

This is a safe space to express doubts or ask for clarification.

4. What did you learn new about Jesus?

Was there something that challenged or expanded your view of Him?

5. What are you going to apply to your life?

Think practically — how can this change the way you live, think, or treat others?

6. Bonus Question: Who else needs to know about this?

Is there someone you feel prompted to share this with?

Facilitator Tips:

- Open and close in prayer.
- Allow everyone space to speak, but don't force anyone to share.
- Encourage honesty questions are just as valuable as answers.
- Keep it respectful, especially if people have differing perspectives.
